Most of my current work is using React with TypeScript on the front-end and a back-end built with Node, Vite, and PostgreSQL.

- Translated legacy Disney+ code to modern styling and frameworks, which consisted mostly of rewriting React class components written in JavaScript to functional React written in TypeScript.
